## MELBOURNE HEALTH EMPLOYEES

### Uniforms and protective clothing

Melbourne Health is required to provide any uniform or special clothing that they require employees to wear to work.

Where the employer does not meet the cost of providing such clothing they are required to pay a uniform allowance. This is set out in clause 111 of the Enterprise Agreement covering Melbourne Health.

Melbourne Health are also required to pay for any gloves, masks, protective clothing and safety appliances that you need to safely perform your job functions.

If you are being forced to pay for your uniform or special clothing without receiving a uniform allowance the Health Workers Union can help you.
