FOOD SERVICE ASSISTANTS

Wash up time

Food Service Assistants can finish ten minutes before the end of their rostered shift for the purposes of washing their hands and changing clothes.

This is a workplace right under clause 156 of the Enterprise Agreement covering public hospitals in Victoria. This is in recognition of the food and other material that they handle in their day to day role.
